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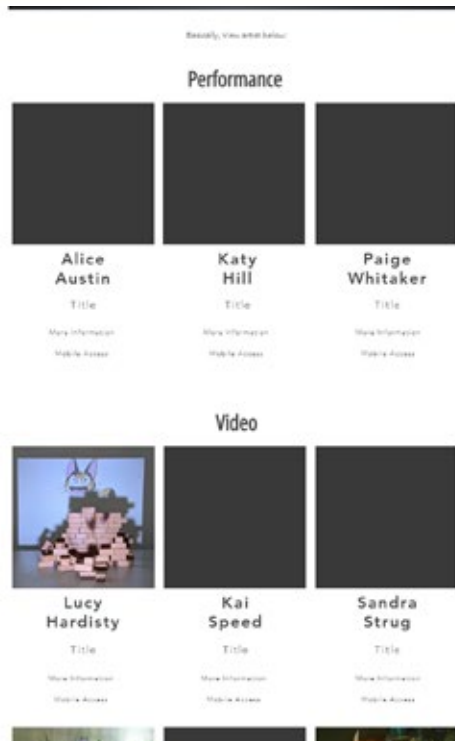

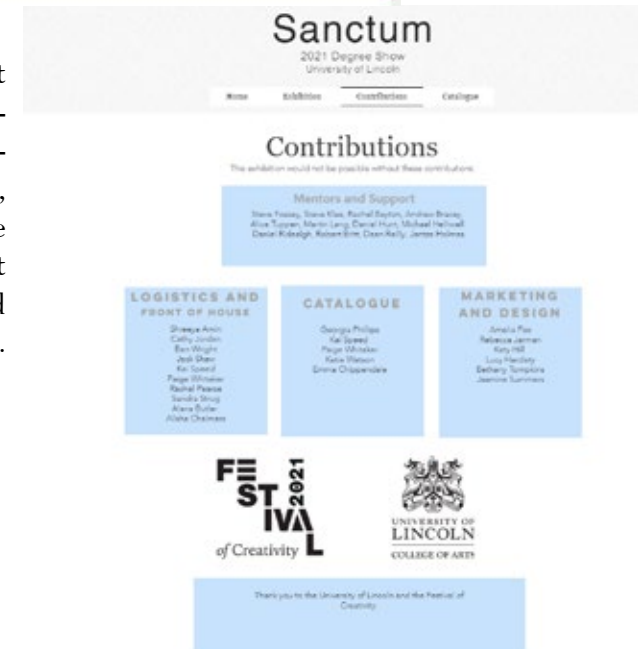

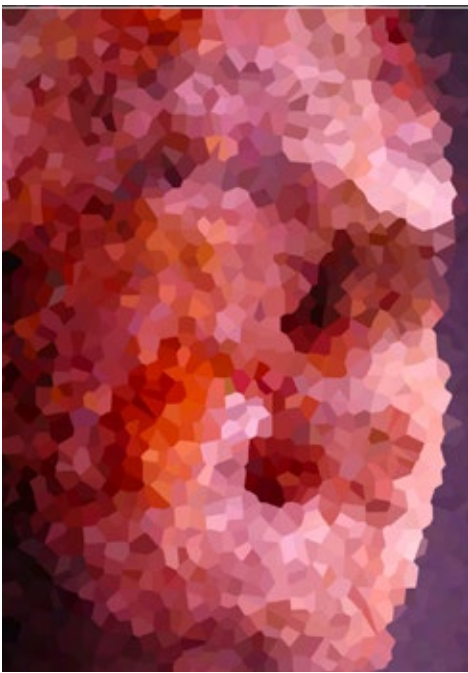
Exhibition/Artists:

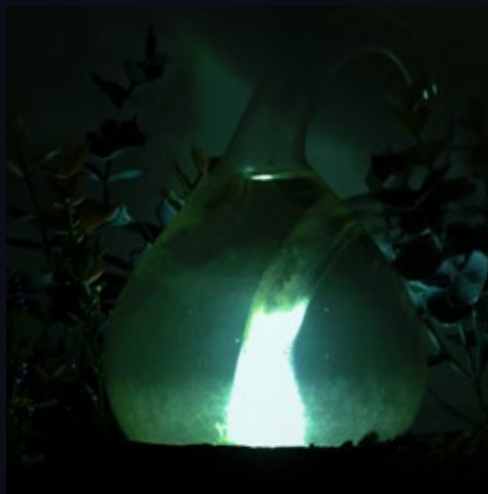
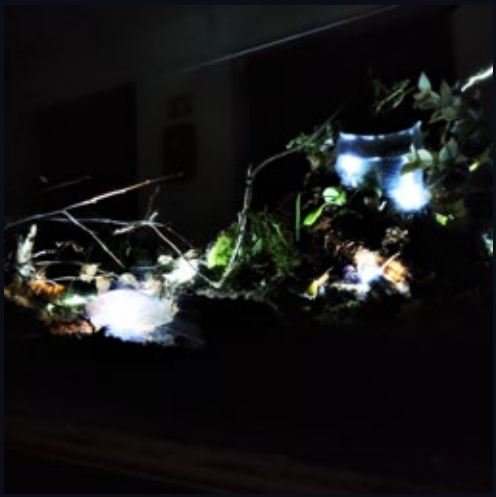




'Segmented Worlds'

Speculation on views on reality and segmenting it into separate areas as a multi room installation, and using darkness for immersion.

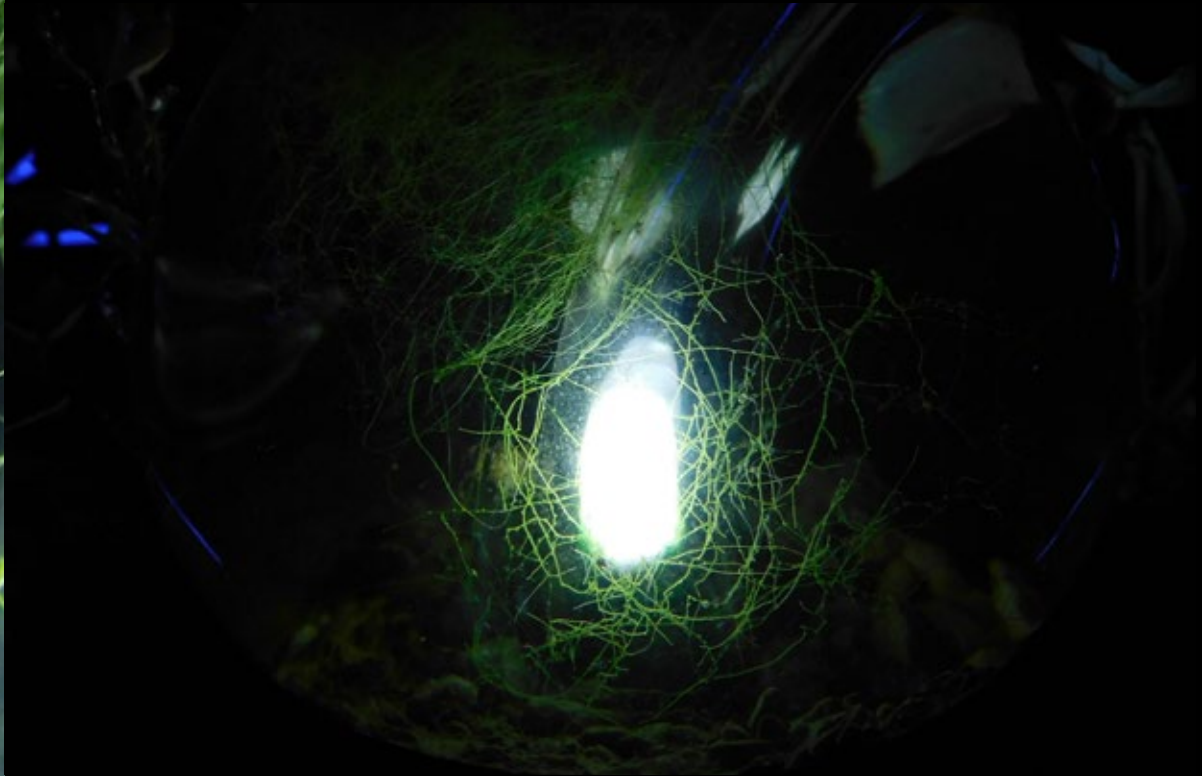


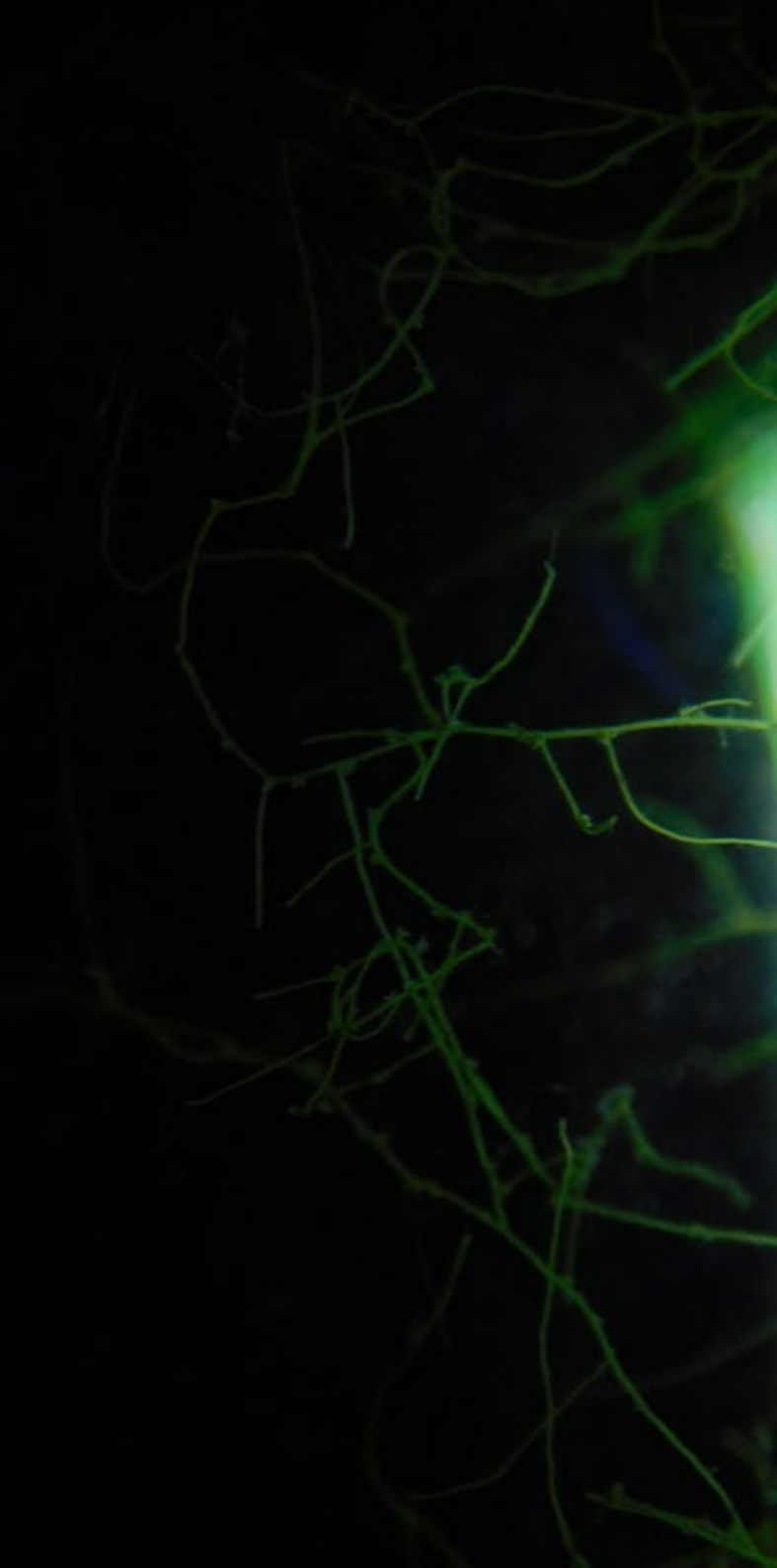
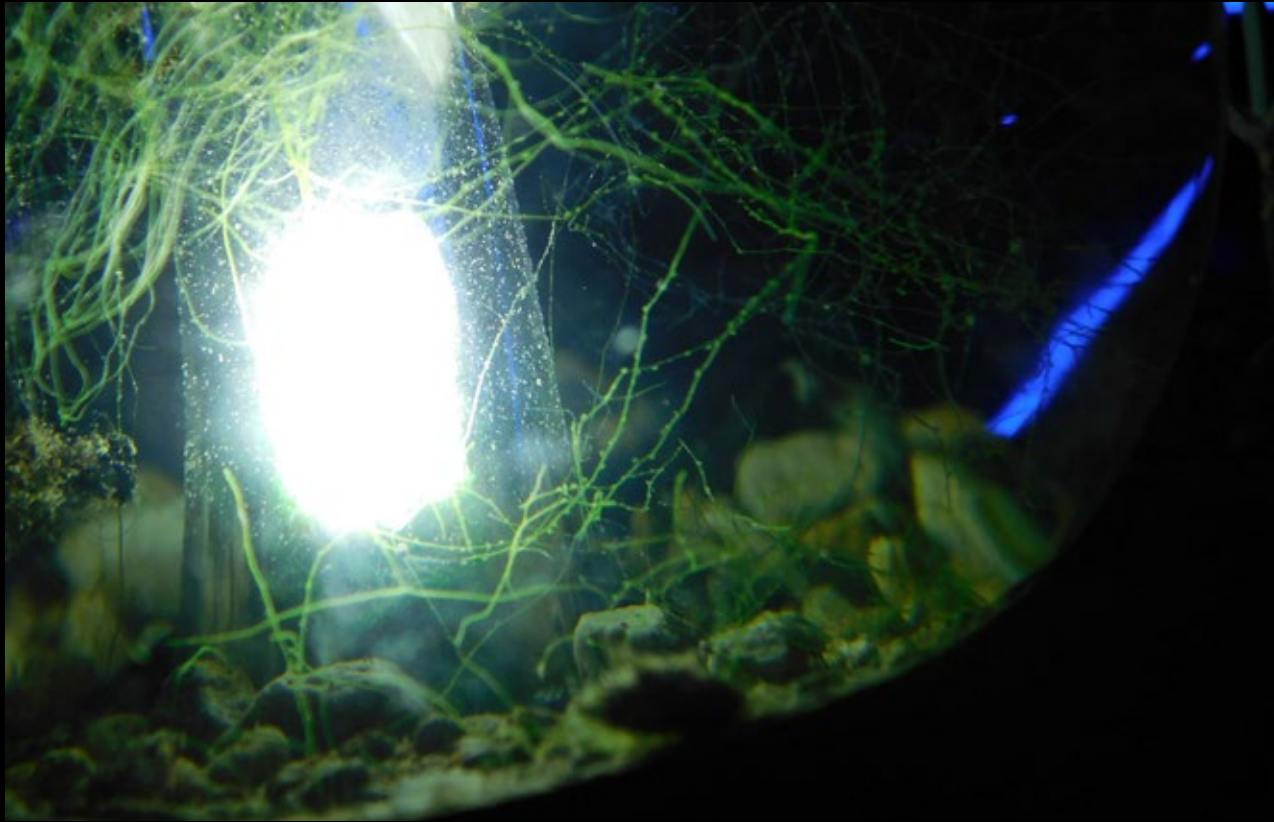
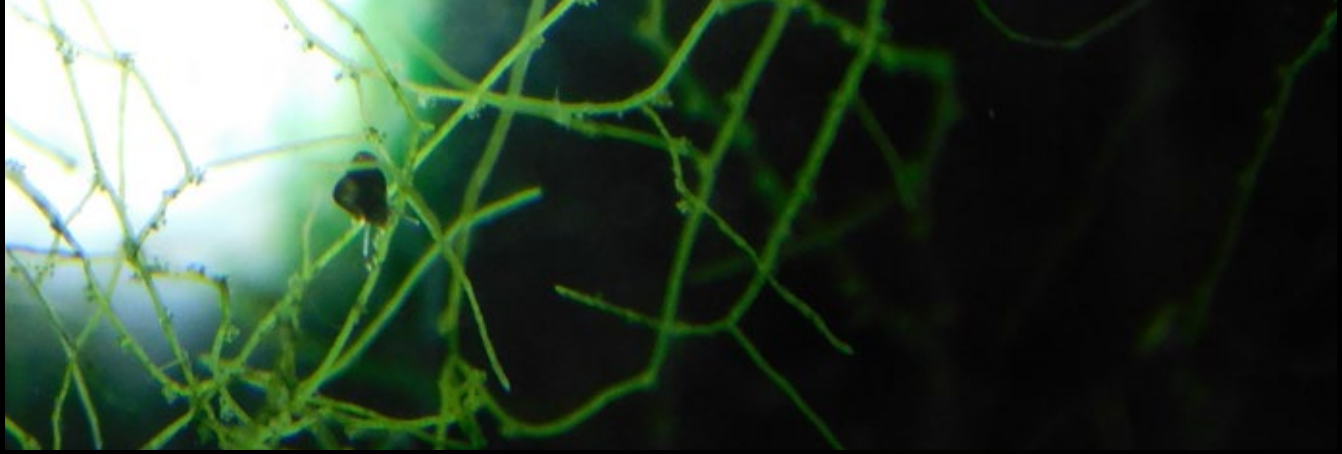




February 2021, development within the Klein Bottle ecosphere

I thought it was a dead ecosystem as I couldn't see any life, however, as of later January and early February I noticed there was a sudden surge of copepods within this sealed container. I am now continuing this project and only getting rid of the closed container once there is no signs of life left.



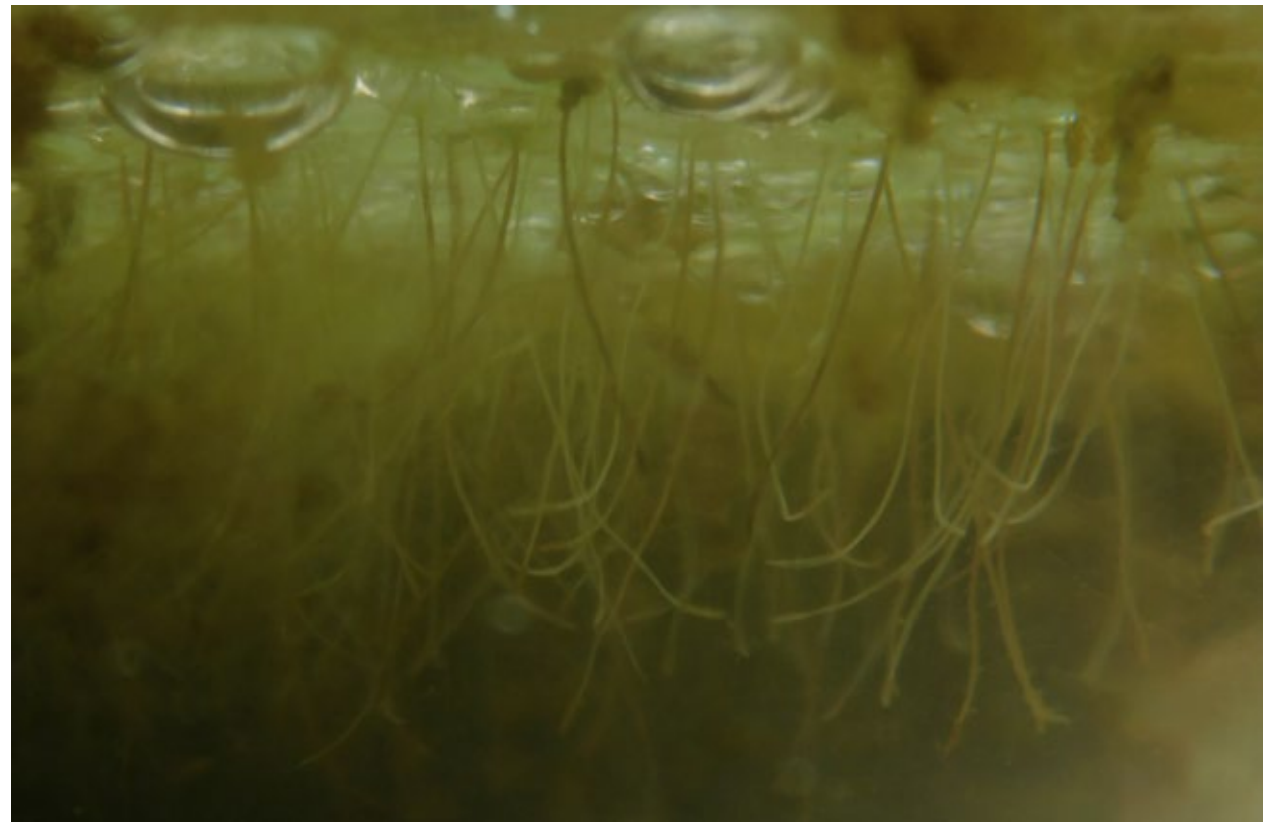


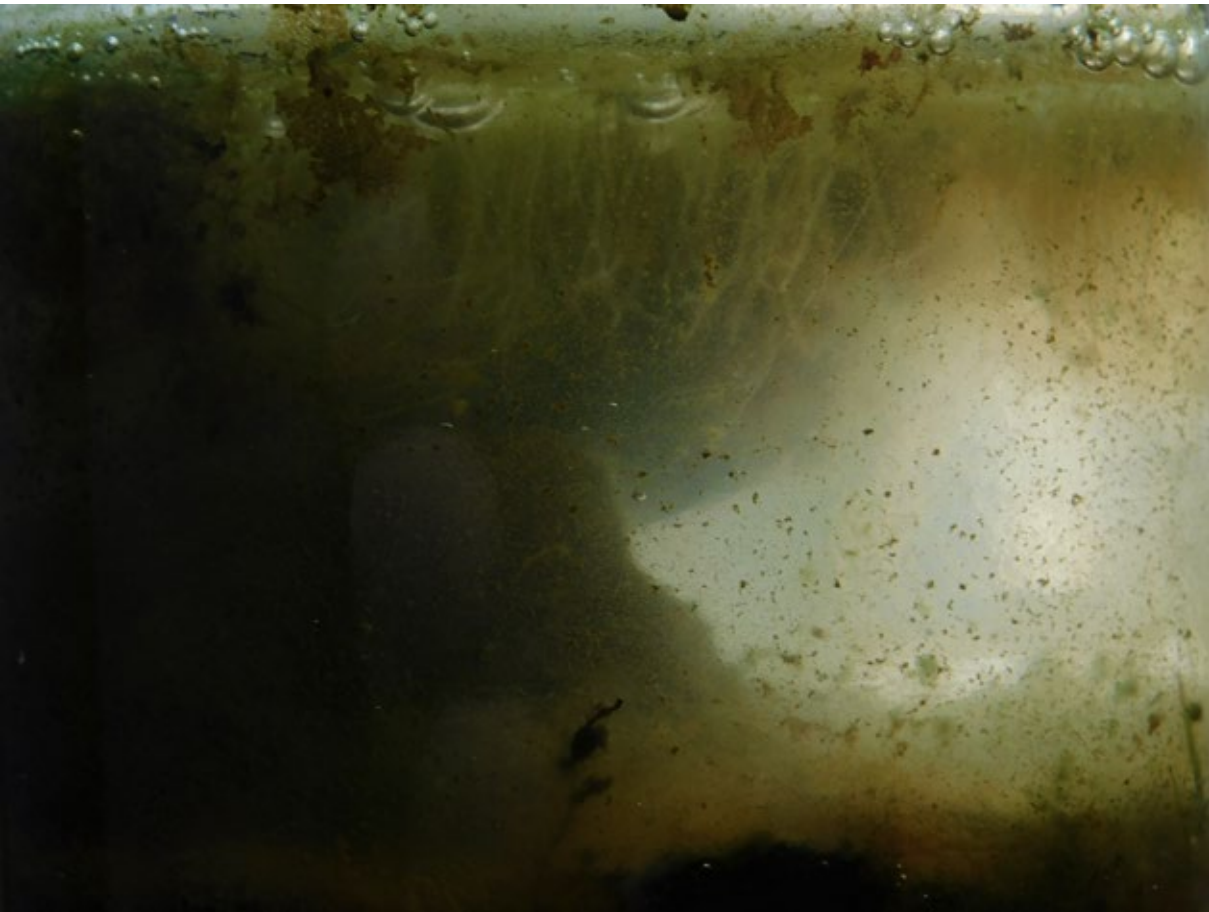

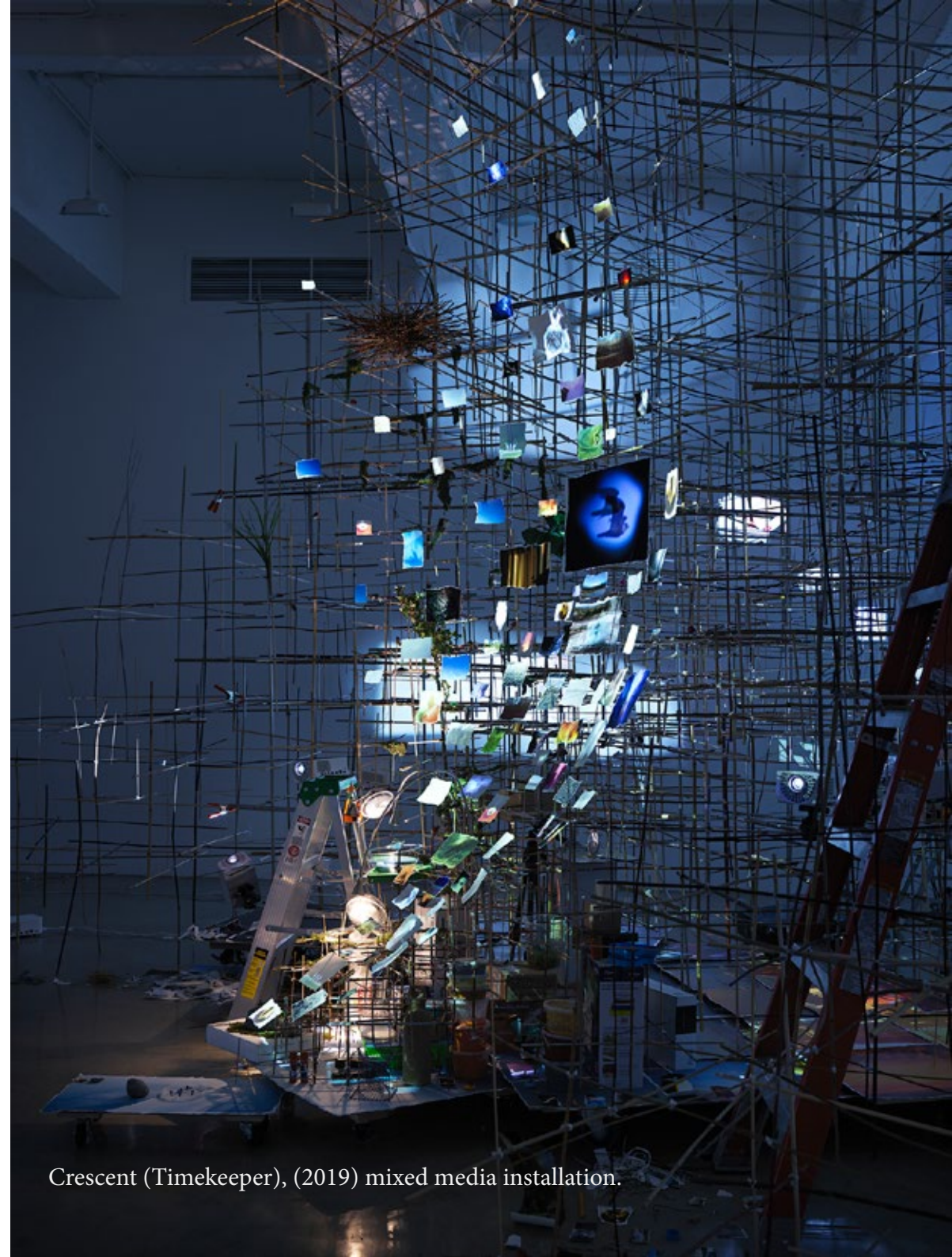




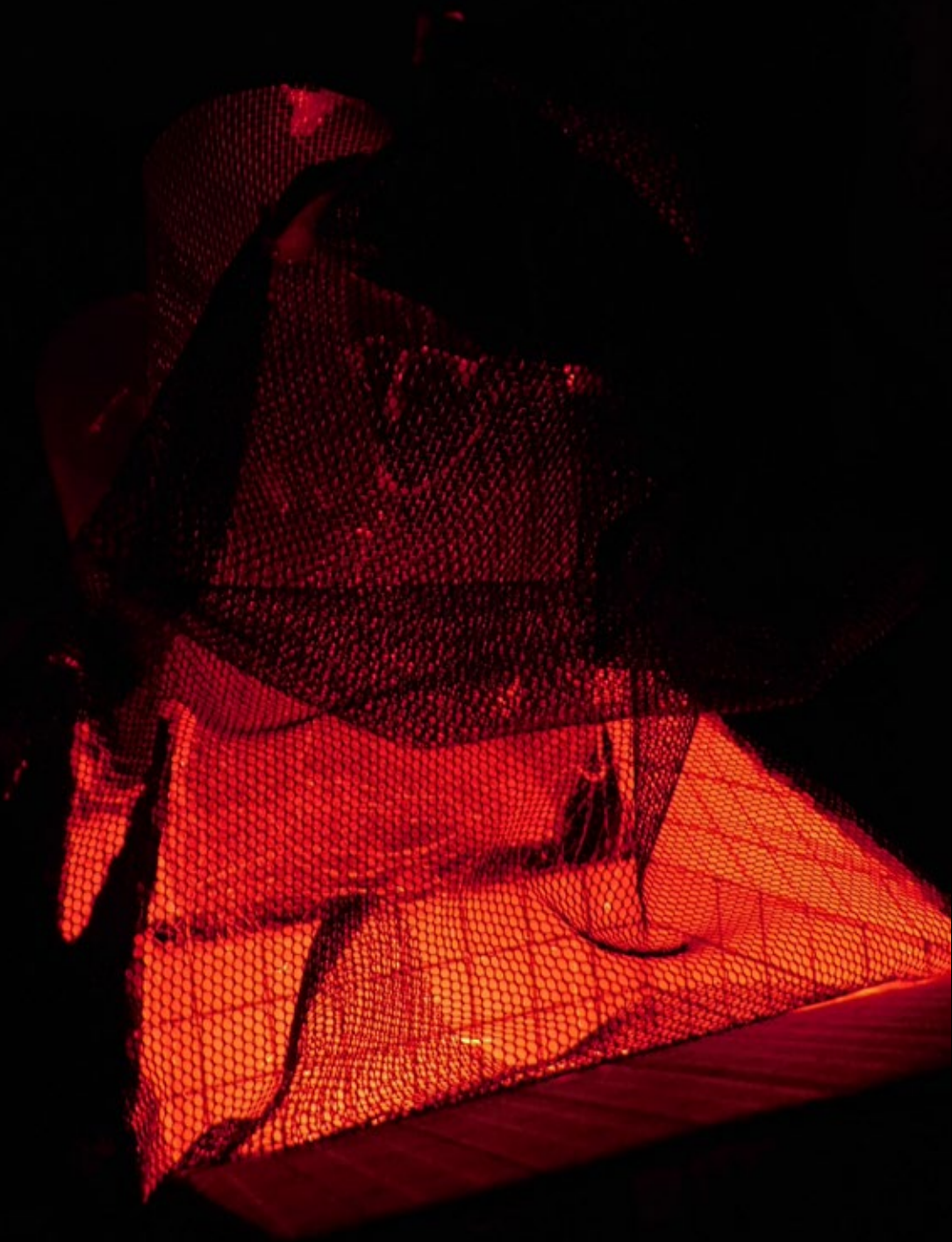
sarah sze

Sarah Sze is an artist that is known for her large-scale installations and sculptures that creates mixed media landscapes for the audience observe, reflect and considering the line between order and chaos. An inspiration of her works that I will take forward is her use of dichotomy, to contrast different materials together into one environment and making ambiguous and open sculptures and sculptural installations which play with the space available for the pieces and to have this dichotic ambiguity with the mediums used.

While there is some elements of found object, which inspired me from the found mirror with a golden frame with the weather worn bricks, her work is carefully curated and organised despite the open and chaotic visuals which I wanted to include in my own process.

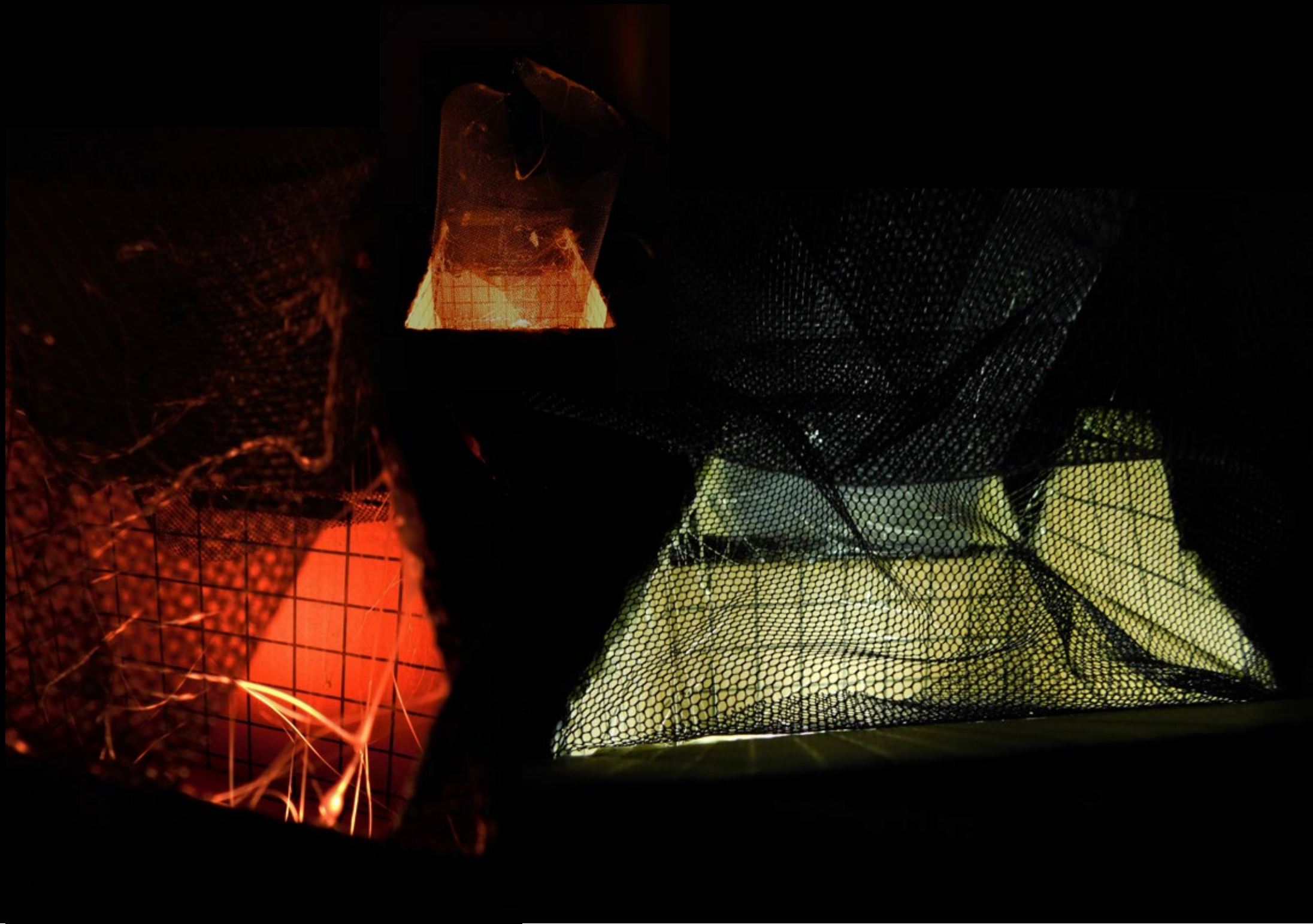


Crescent (Timekeeper), (2019) mixed media installation.



Ambiguous sculpture test, using darkness and different light colours and angles, the red light is very imposing and powerful, while the others don't quite work as well inside the mesh and hot glue.







I loved how the light is reflected within the hot glue and the texture of the mesh, however, I was not sure on the box itself and the materials.

Speculative Covid Sculptures







When I was waiting outside of Morrison's in the car, as at the time I was too anxious of public spaces because of the Coronavirus, I noticed that people continued as they would out of habit. I noticed a few separate people that would take a trolley that just left the store, and they would take the previous persons trolley to disinfect afterwards.

I also noticed that people only clean the handlebars, however, people handle other areas of the trolley inside the supermarket while they are walking about or moving the trolley to the side. This sculpture is inspired by that as once the trolley was suspended, I lightly brushed it with water, and put a small amount of glow in the dark powder on only the handle.

What ended up happening was the fallout and air distance created would dust the rest of the trolley in glow in the dark powder, which was representing Covid-19.

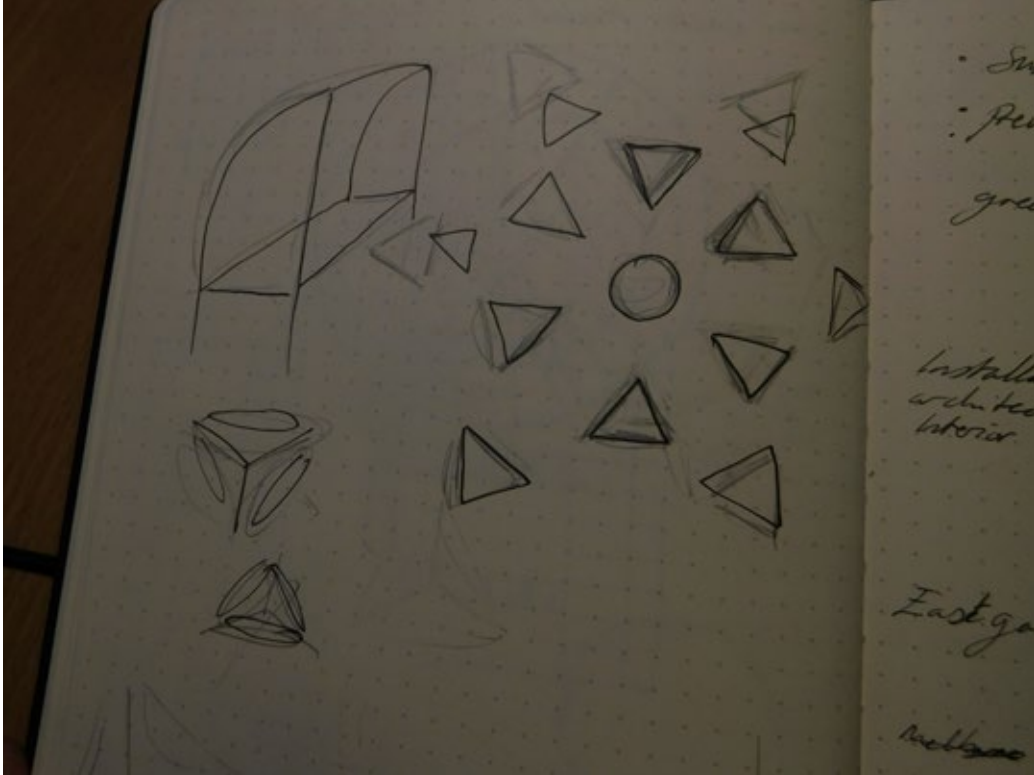


While I could not get a clear photo, I quite liked how the powder had a partial silhouette of the trolley, with enough of the trolley hidden so that only once you already know what it is, do you see it more clearly.





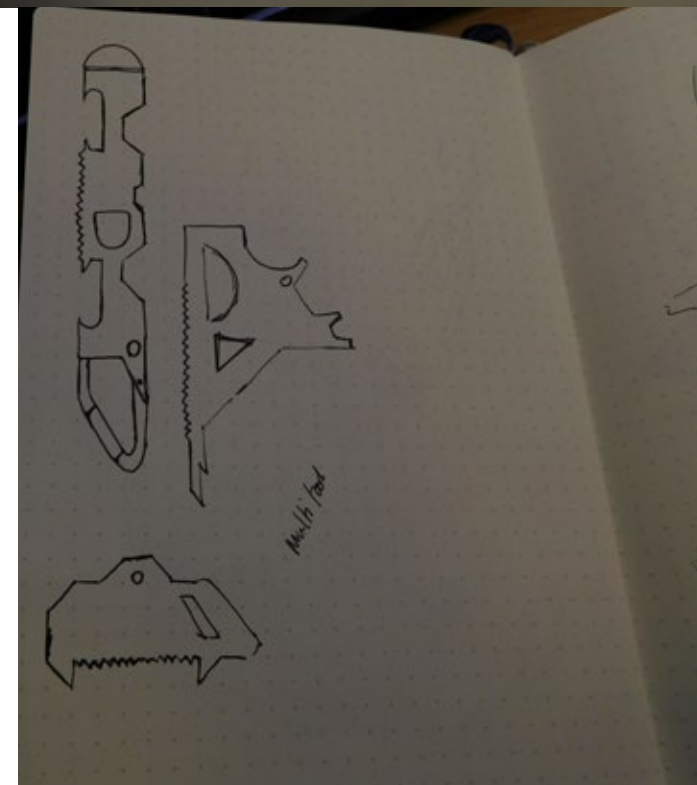

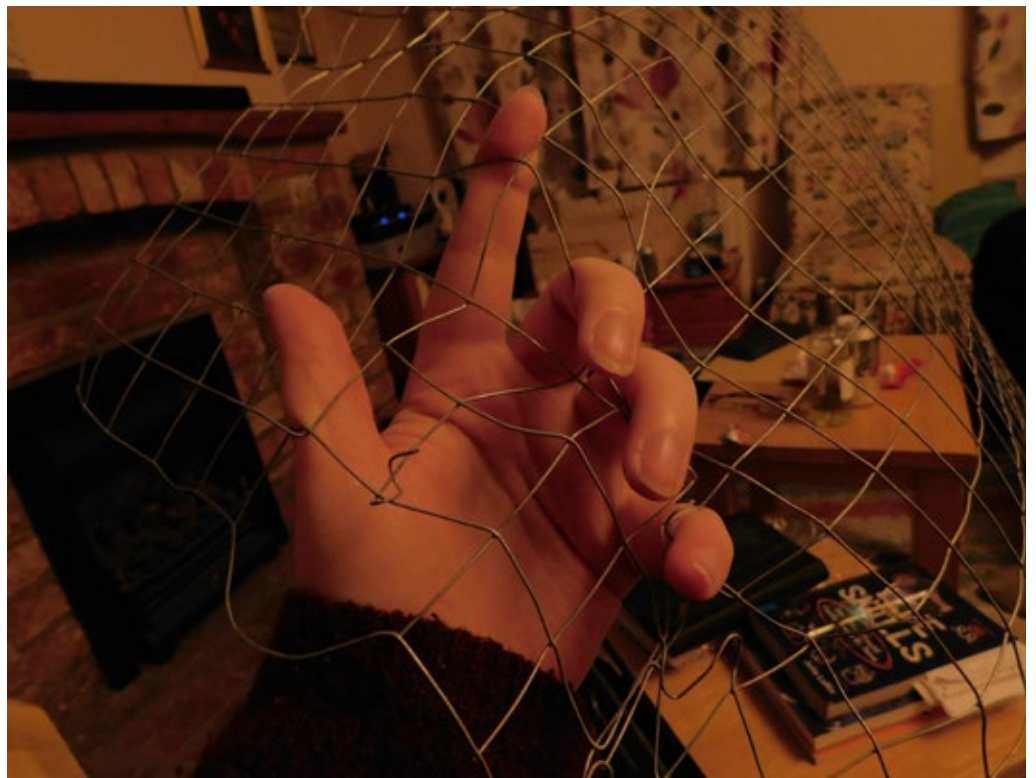
Continuing on with the Coronavirus themes, I decided on trying to make speculative space for practical use, so the image on the top left, is of a design for benches that are socially distanced and private but still being part of something bigger.

The images on the right were of speculative multitools, that seem familiar but wouldn't quite work as you would want it to.

While these were interesting I believed it wasn't quite the right balance between art, design, and architecture, and it was beginning to be too literal so I decided to try and do some more instinctual pieces so I didn't make it literal.



Mesh wire manipulation and photography













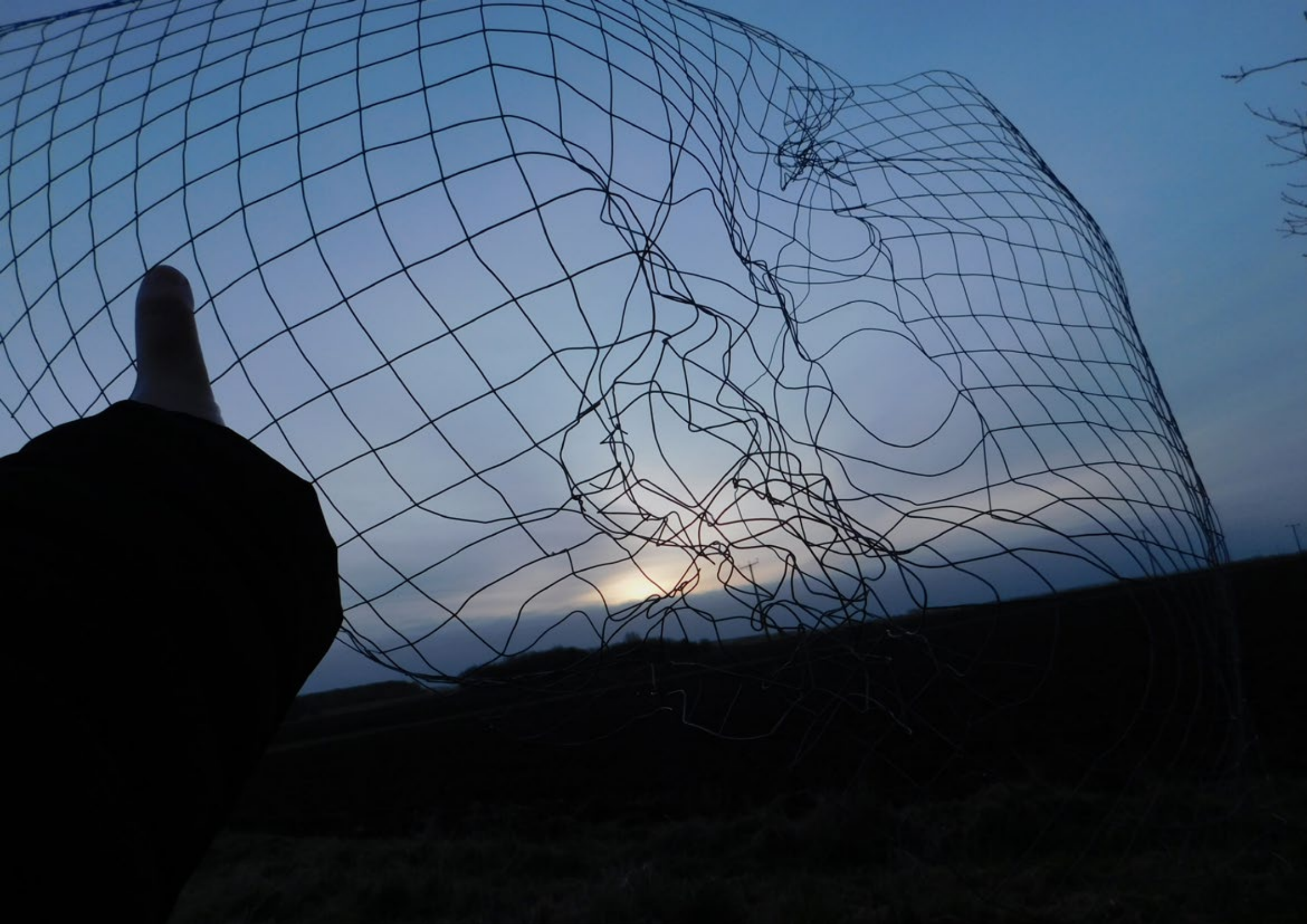




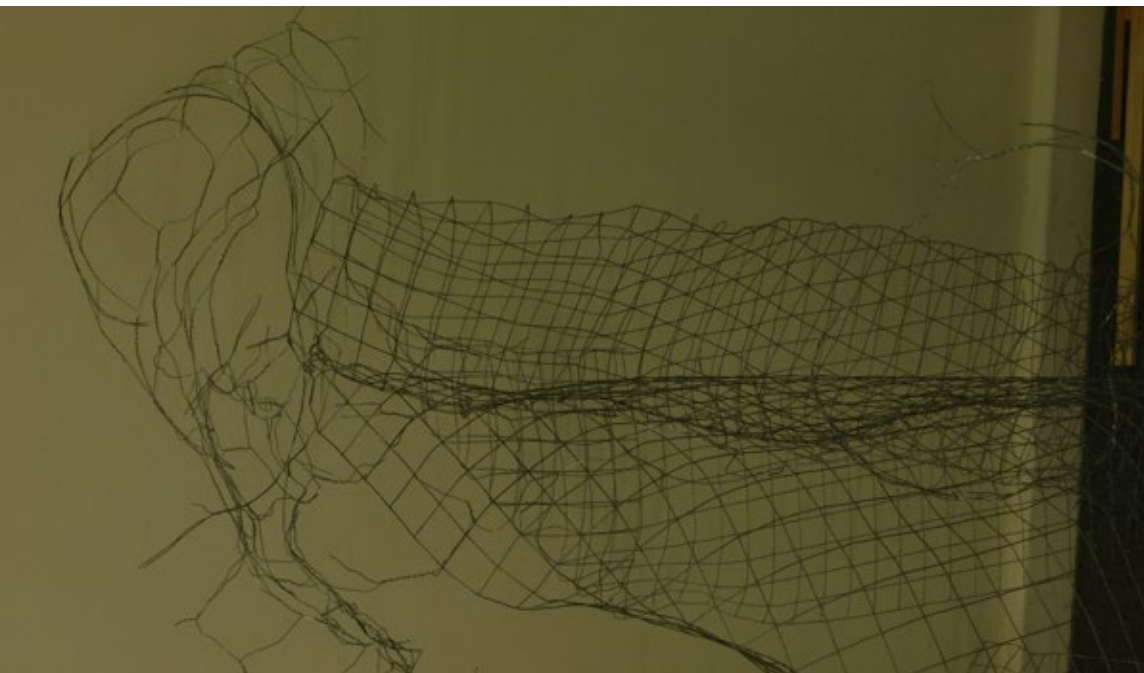
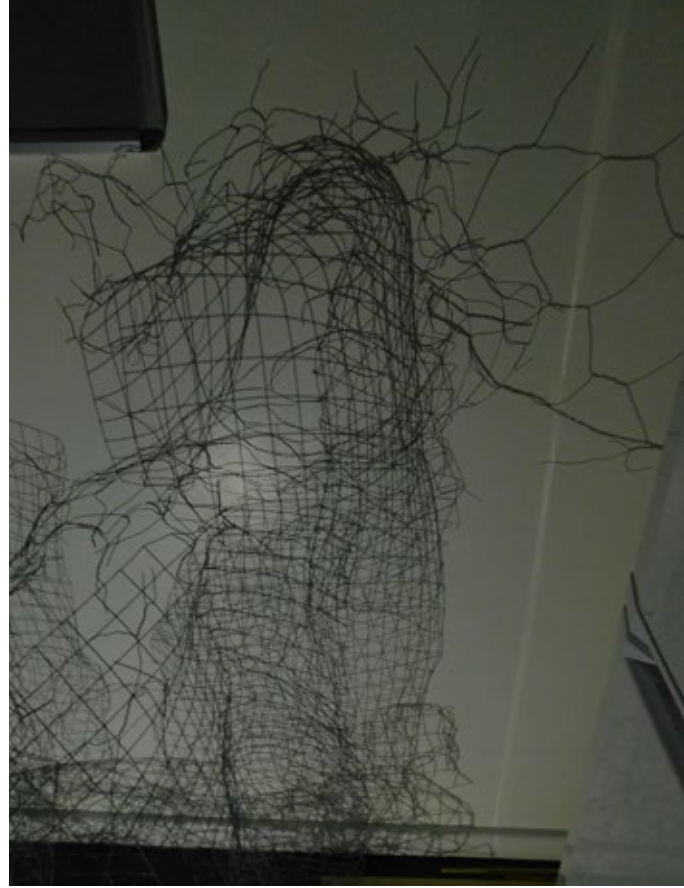
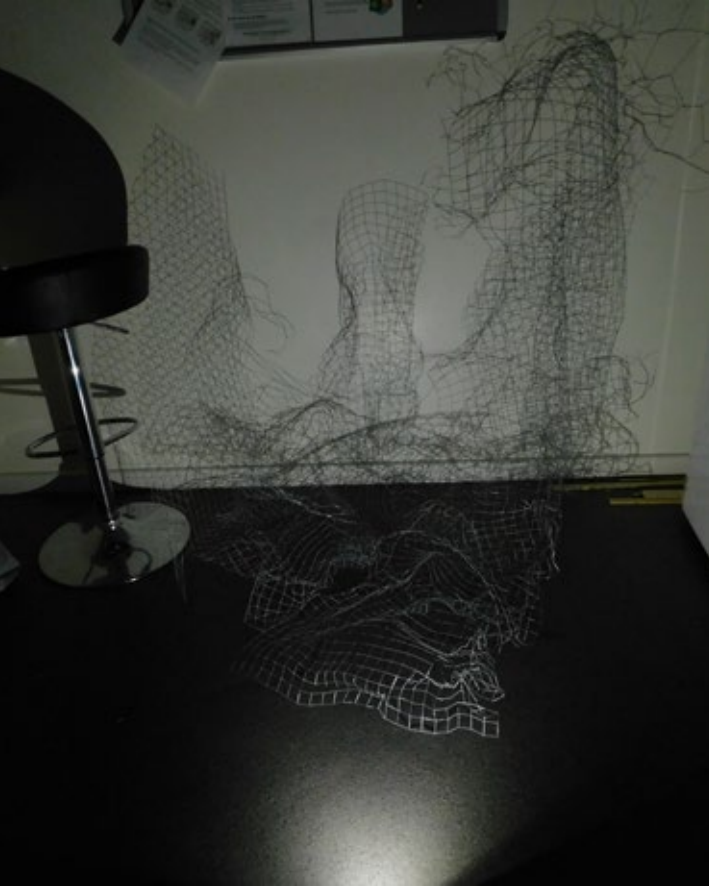
I decided to experiment with space by distorting a panel of mesh with only using my hands. Mesh is often used for protection and a deterrent, both in rural and urban environments using this as inspiration I continued forward to create a larger scale piece with distorted mesh and chicken wire to create a speculative environment, which is ambiguous on if it is intended for rural or urban, while also being open to interpretation of what the space is, what is its intended use and how is it perceived by the individual.







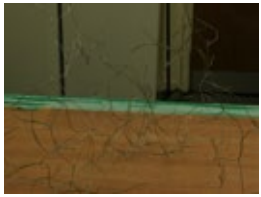
‘Distorted Mesh’



Testing distorted mesh and wire with a flashlight to see the shadows on the wall.



I tested the wire on the wall, attached by a singular nail. I liked that the metal was clearer on the wall as when it was on the floor it lost its shape quite a bit



I did chicken wire experiments which I noticed that it felt a lot more organic and natural than the grid panels, which resulted in the mesh panels and chicken wire working together very well.





While the shadows looked really good close up, I did not feel it was right to try and set up a light to shine onto it, as the light would need to move around and it would have distracted from the mesh.





I had considered using a neon light within the mesh, however, after testing the lights in the space. I realised that the neon yellow and orange would be drowned out by the light inside the space.

The Plaque fell off, so I added some more double-sided tape and repositioned the plaque away from the mesh.



I added multiple hooks to make the mesh fit and form to the entire wall.

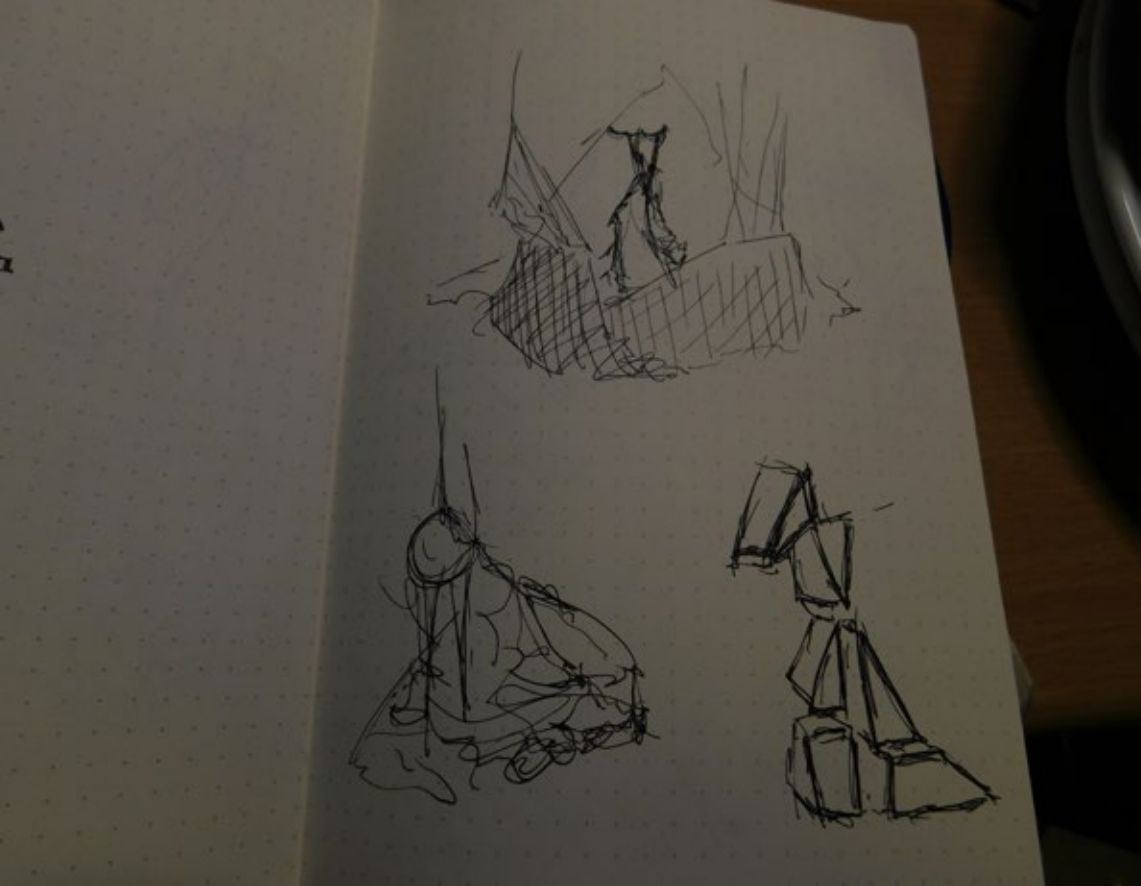

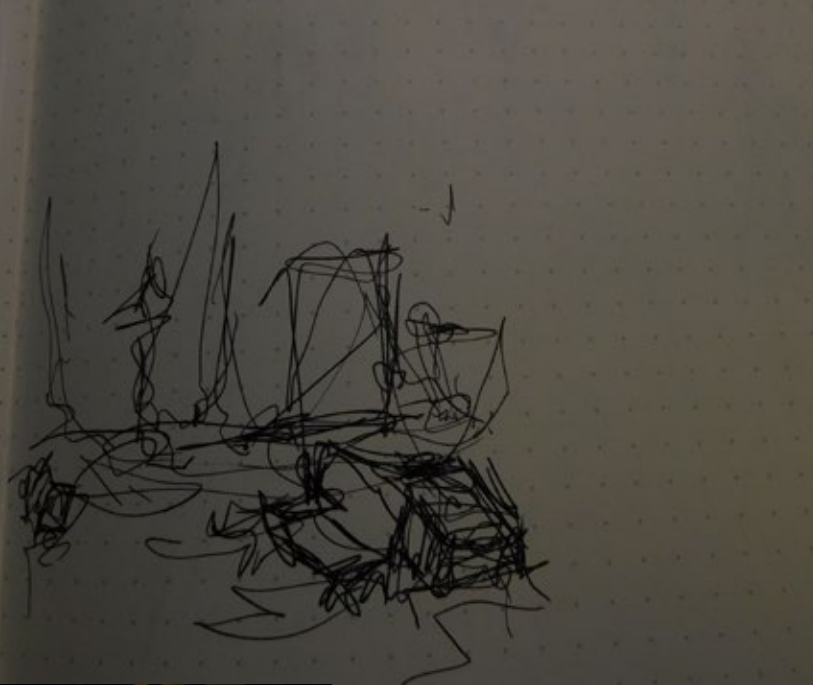




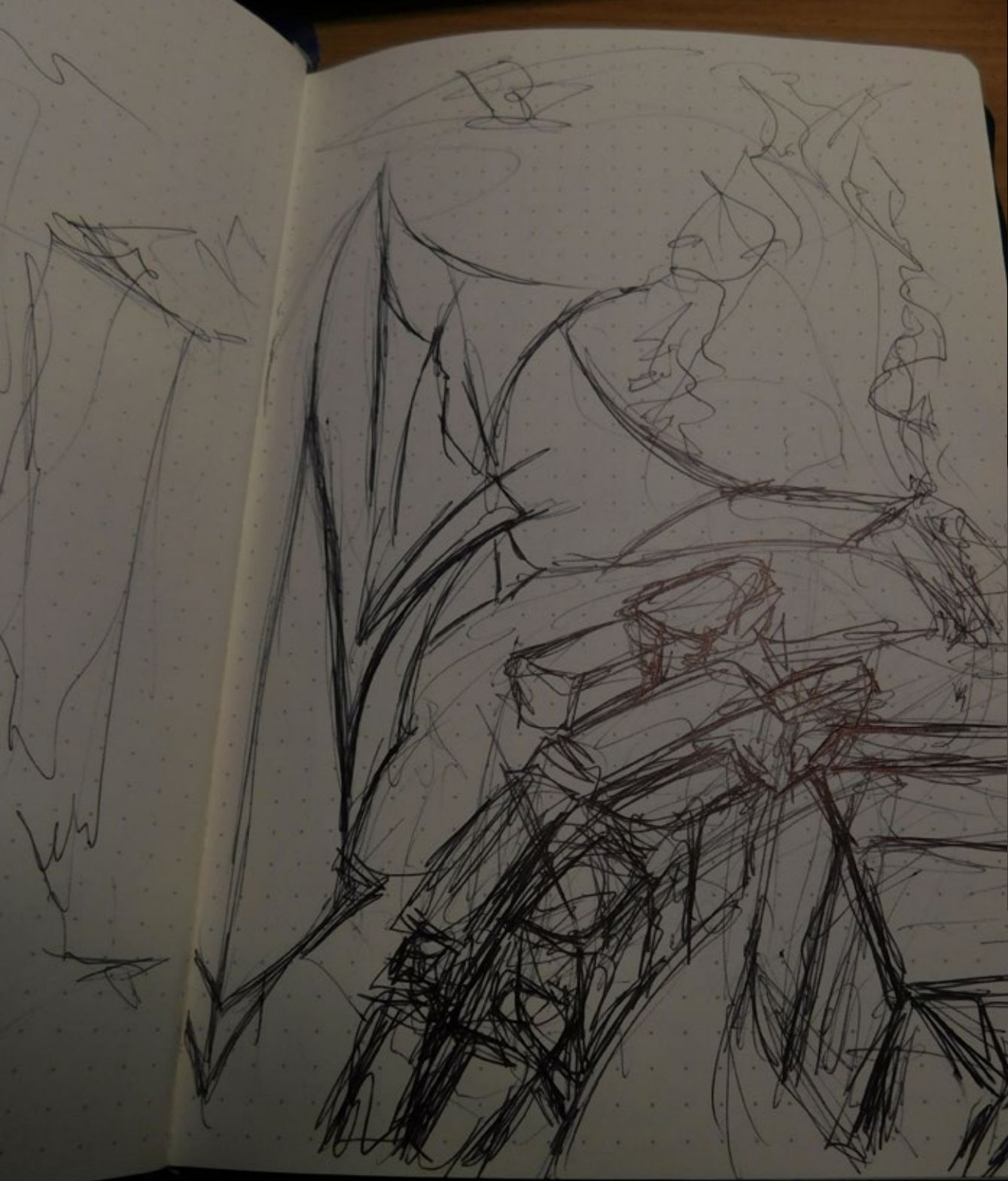
These were inspired by 'Speculative' toys' which seemed to be a toy or form of entertainment, e.g. jack in the box, marionette, etc.

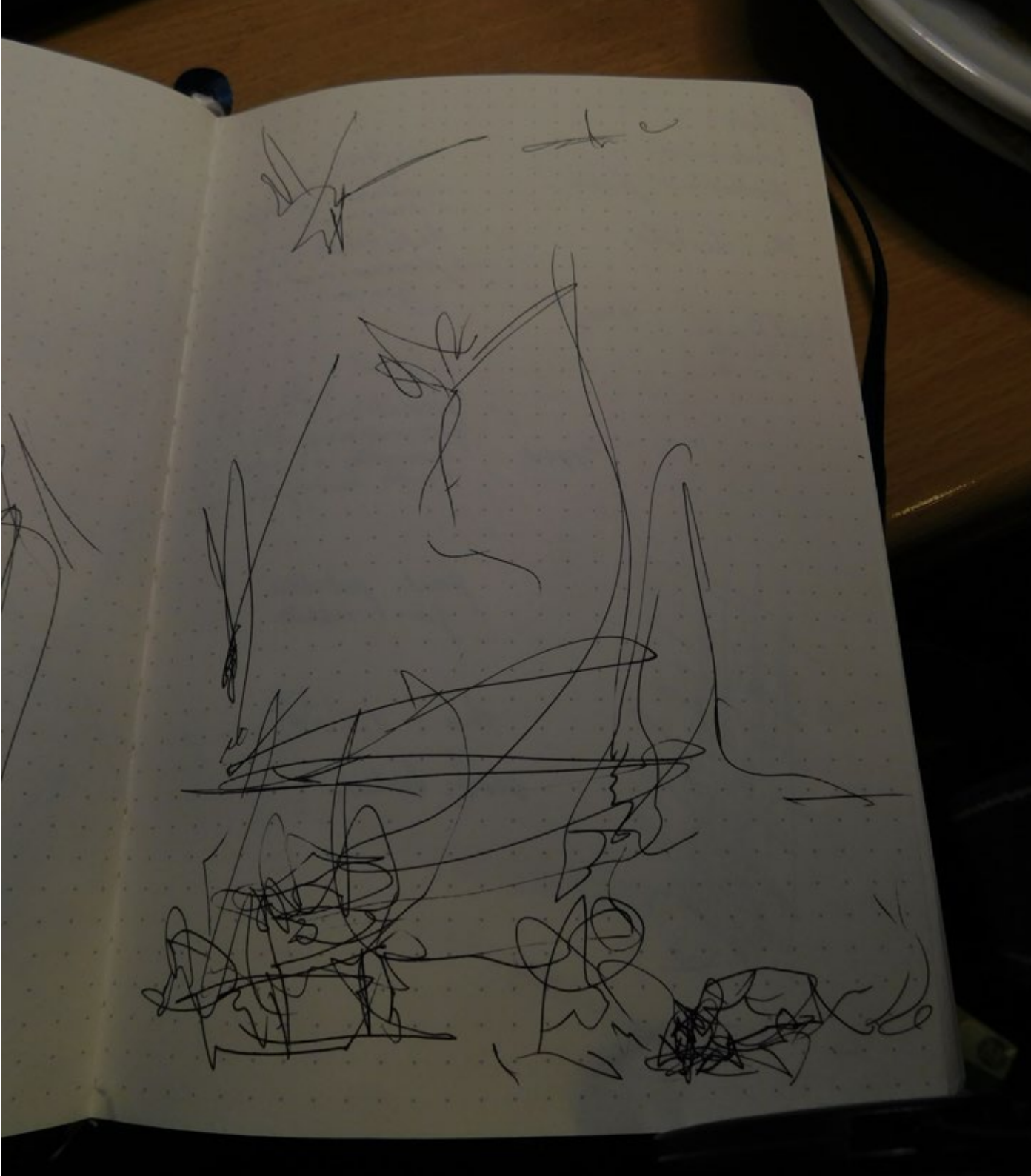

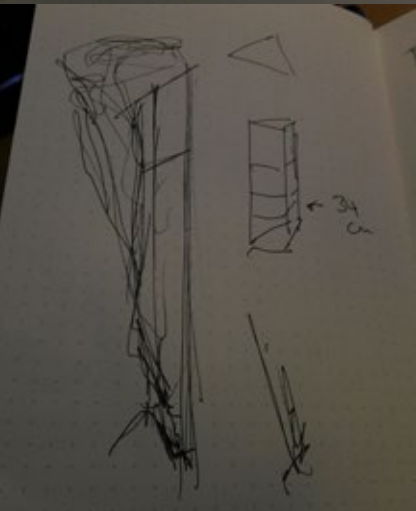






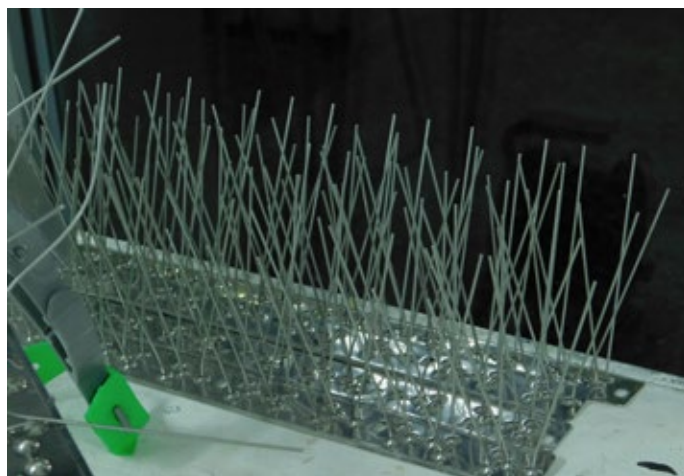
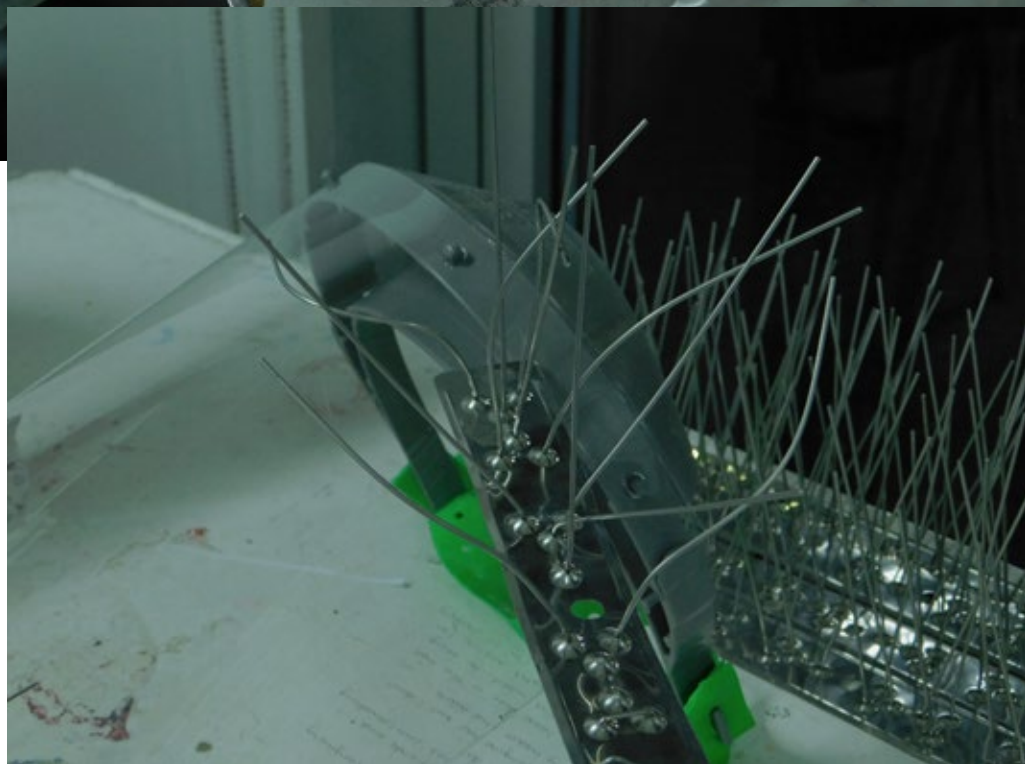
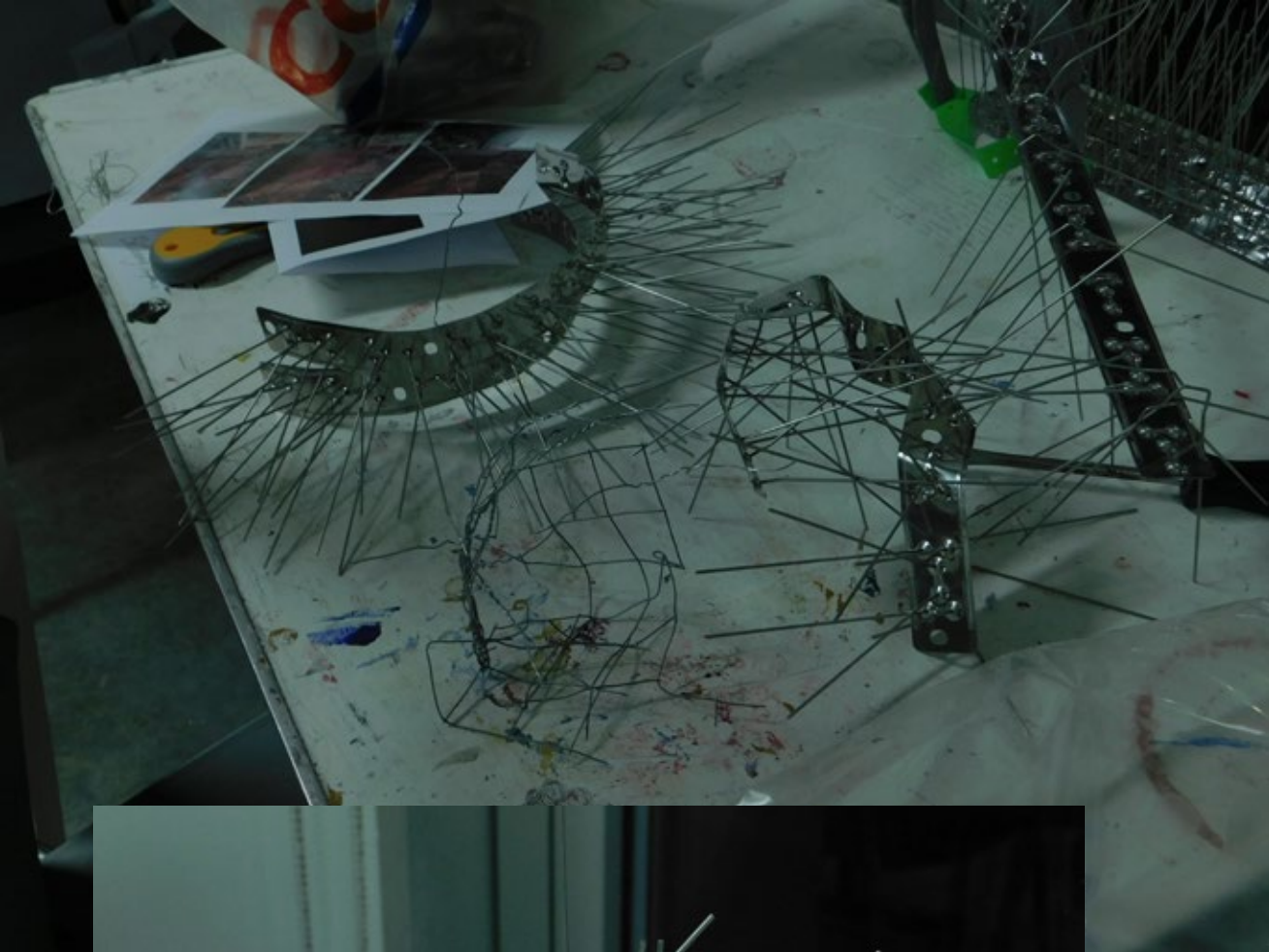
I decided to create a support to attach to the vertical sculpture, to help stabilise and to reduce any potential warping and making sure there is not too much pressure at the base of the original design, as it became more weaker than I originally intended.

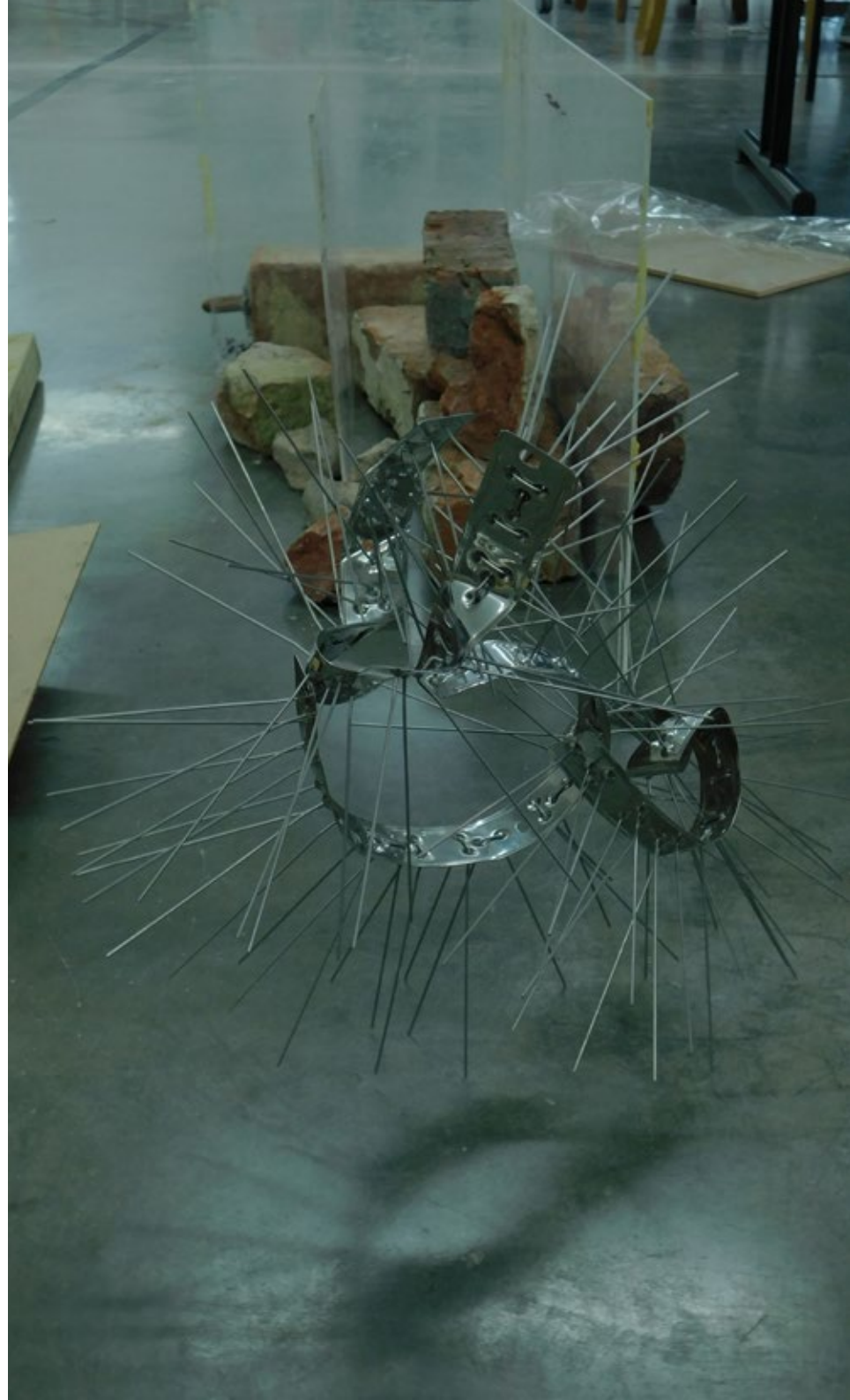
The triangle design was the final design I went with, with bars attached every 35cm to match with the grid on the smaller metal sculpture.

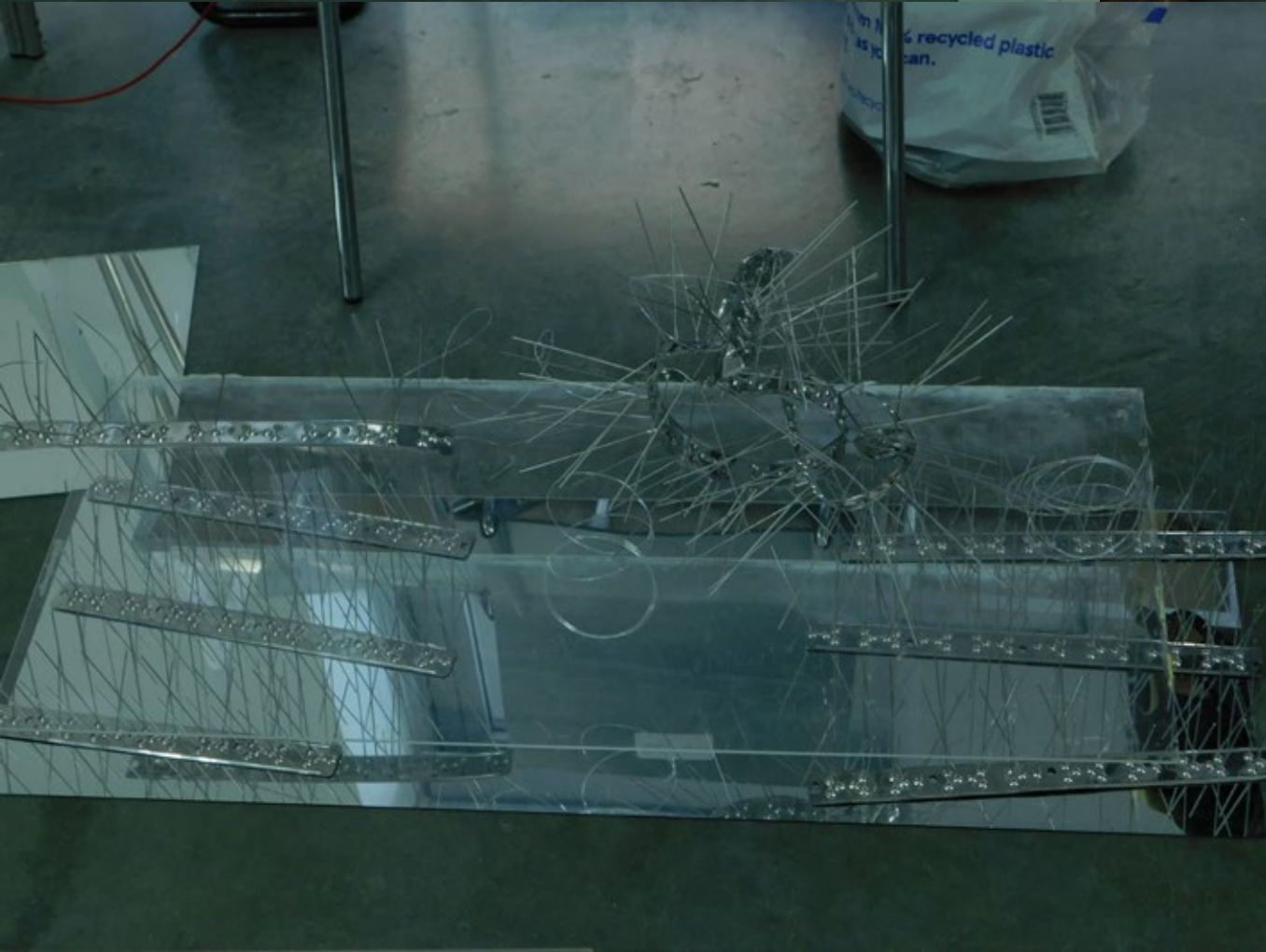
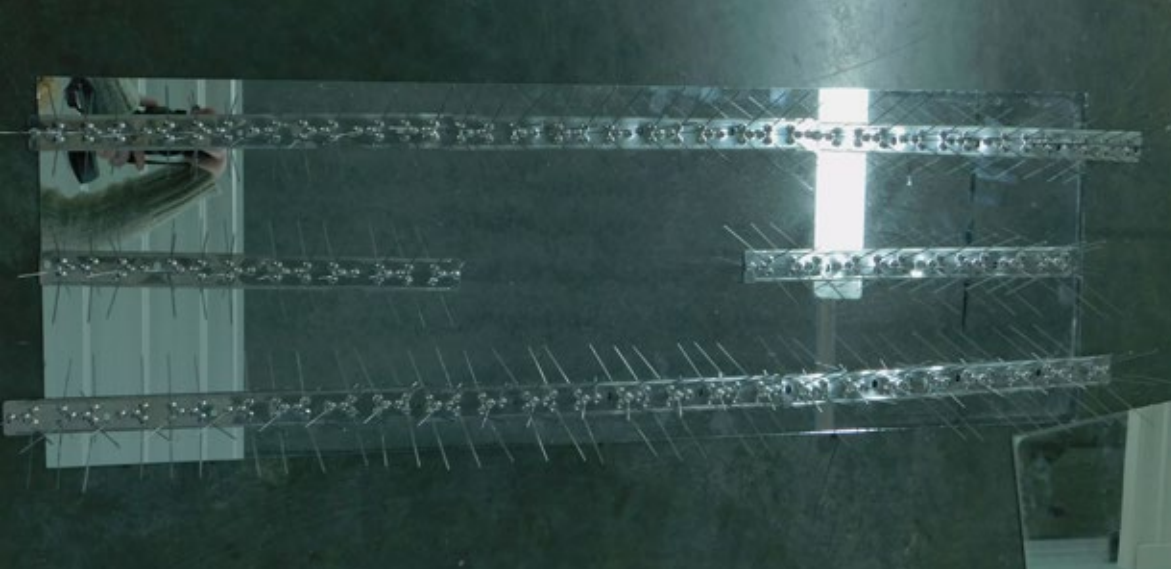






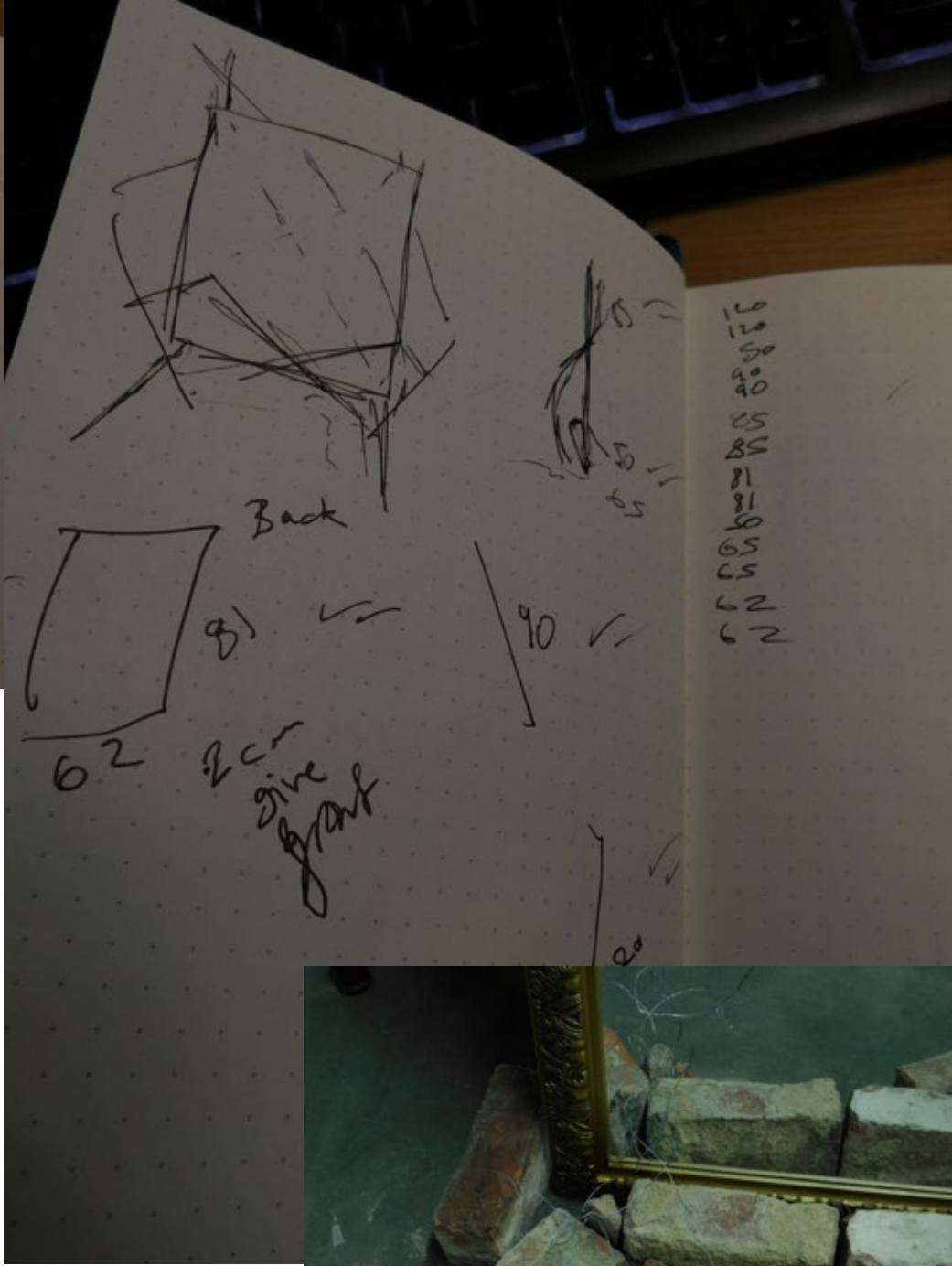
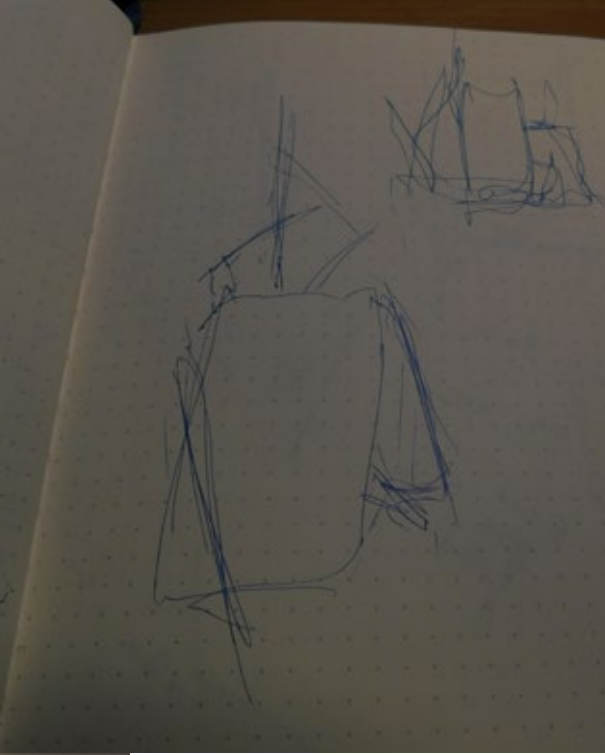


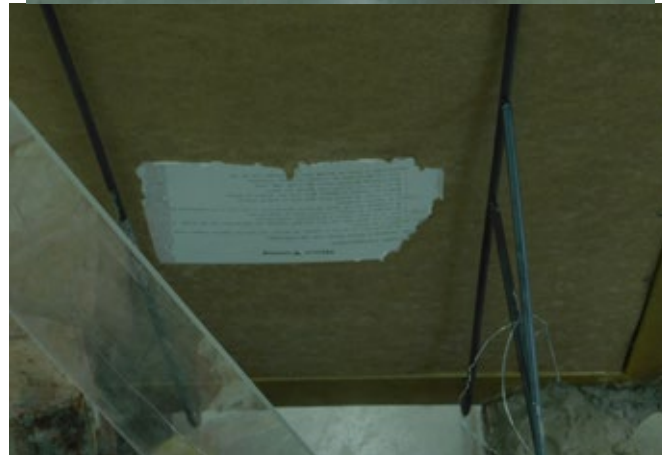




‘Framed Mirror’







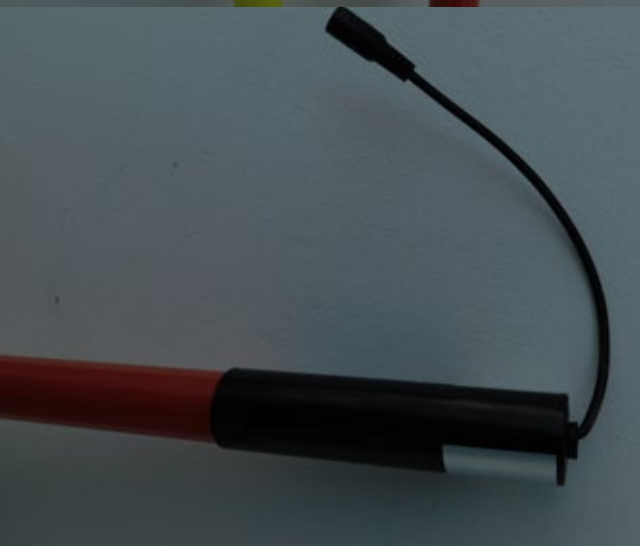
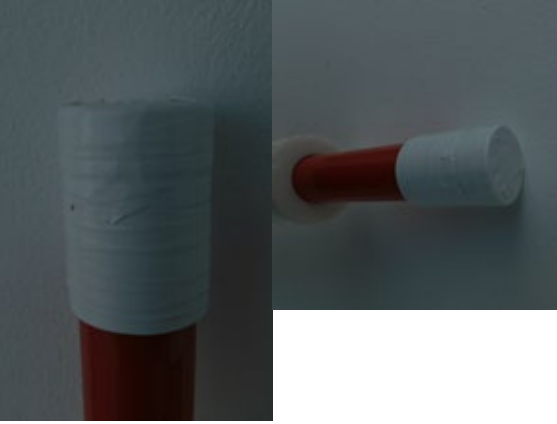

‘Neon Pigeon Spikes’

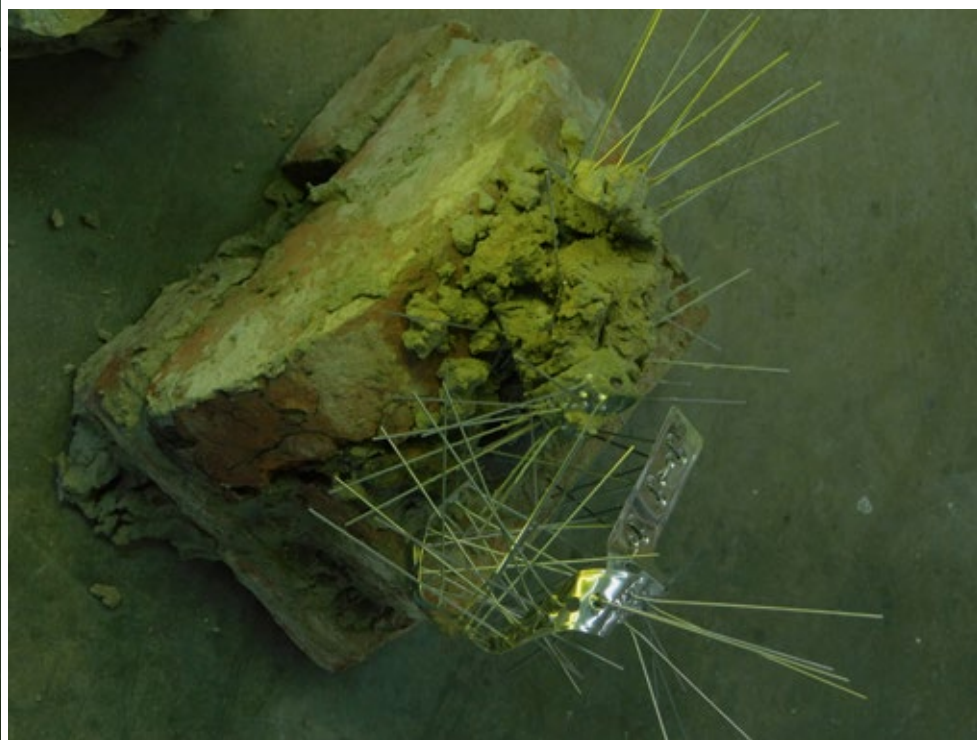


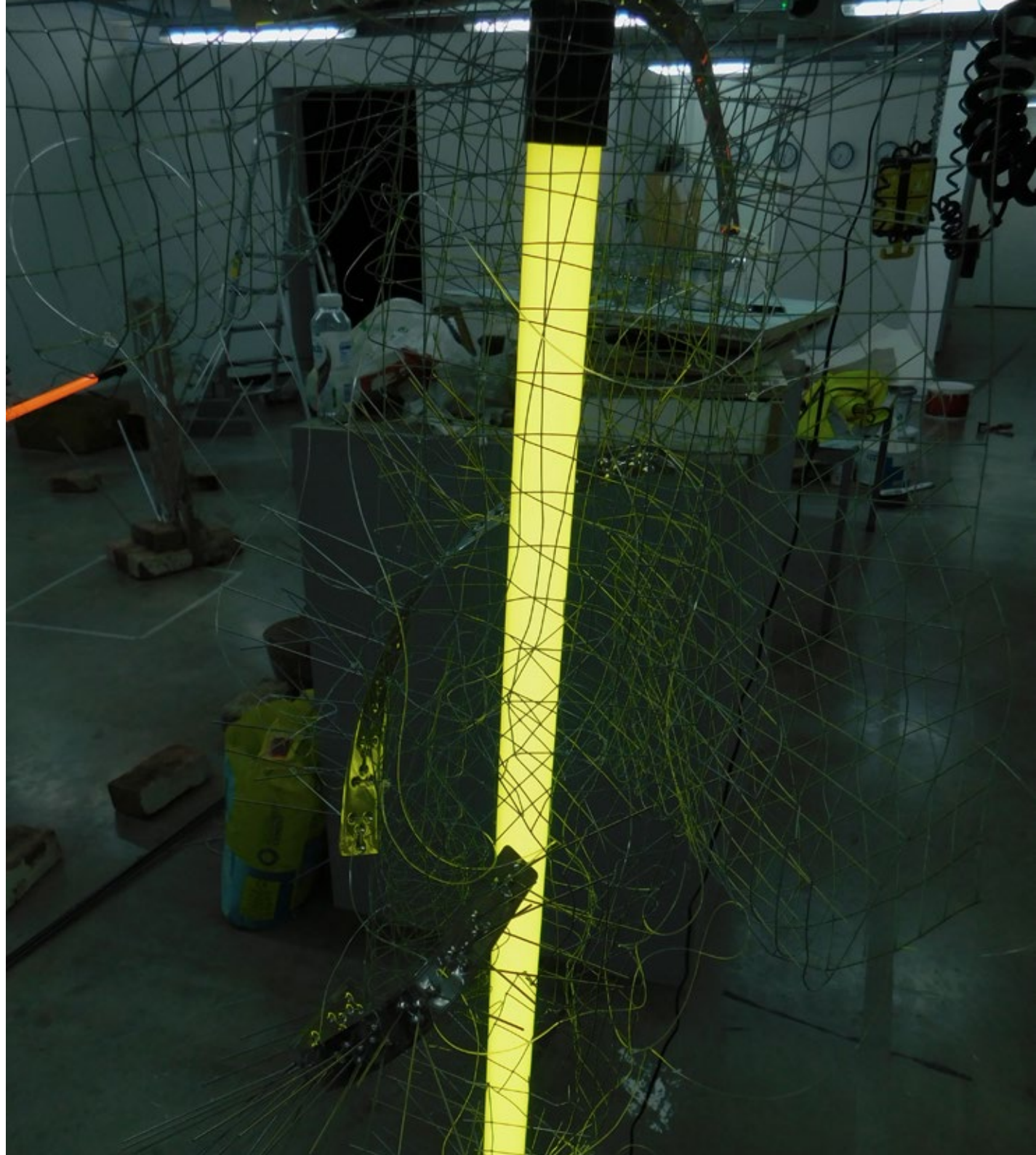
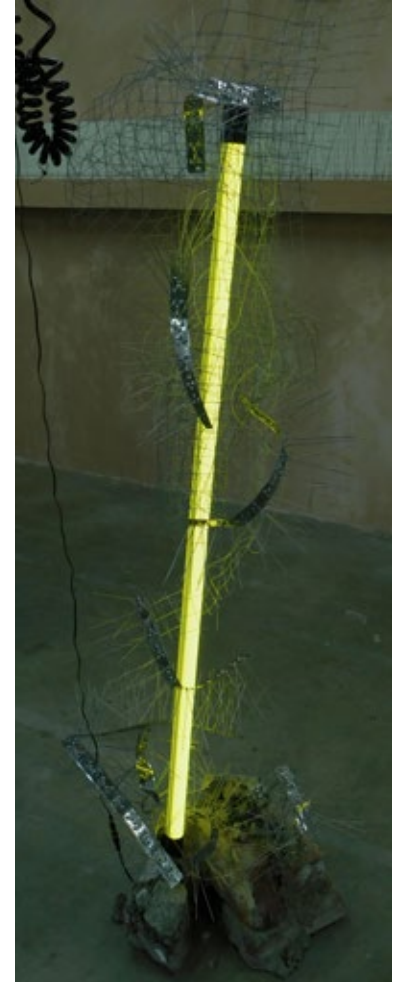
